

Year 1 task a day

Day	Task
1	<p>Maths – Number</p> <p>Using playing cards, assign values of 1 to the ace, 11 to the jack, 12 to the queen, and 13 to the king, and face value for the cards two through 10</p> <p>Playing in pairs, both players chooses 2 cards and lays them out face up, then subtracts the lower number from the higher. Whoever has the higher answer wins all four cards. If the totals are the same, the players flip over two more cards and repeat until there is a winner.</p>
2	<p>English – Word game</p> <p>Play 'Word with in a word'</p> <p>How many small words can you find in this long word?</p> <p>Congratulations</p>
3	<p>Maths – Guess my shape</p> <p>The first player draws a picture of a 2D or 3D shape. The other players have to guess by asking a range of questions which can only be answered with a 'yes' or 'no'</p>
4	<p>English – Instructions</p> <p>Write a set of instructions of how to plant a seed</p> <p>Remember to use a range of verbs and connectives</p>
5	<p>Maths – Quick Mental Oral Calculations</p> <p>Play 'Bang Bang'</p> <p>2 players stand back to back, cowboy shootout style. A question is called out, such as 'what is 5 + 7?' The first player to turn, face their opponent, shout 'bang bang' and to give the correct answer wins a point.</p> <p>This is then repeated until the first player who gets to 5 points is the winner.</p>
6	<p>Topic – Science</p> <p>How many plants can you name?</p> <p>Write a list of plants/trees that grows in the UK</p>
7	<p>English - Letter</p> <p>Goldilocks went into the house of bears with asking permission</p> <p>Write a sorry letter to the bears from Goldilocks</p> <p>To write a good letter, the letter must contain the features of a letter: your address top right hand side, Dear three bears on the left side.</p> <p>Remember to use interesting openers, adjectives and connectives.</p>
8	<p>Topic – Vehicles</p> <p>The history of bicycle</p> <p>Draw and label pictures of a bike form the past and from the present</p> <p>Write about the similarities and differences.</p>
9	<p>Topic – Art</p> <p>Using a pencil and a mirror, sketch a self portrait from the front and from the side</p>  
10	<p>English – Description</p> <p>Invent a new animal. Draw and describe what it looks like, what it sounds like, how it moves, and what it eats. Is it scary or cuddly or something else altogether?</p> <p>Would it be a pet or live in the wild?</p> <p>Remember to use a range of adjectives, openers and connectives</p>
