8	Practise your number bonds to and within 20. Can you apply these to number bonds to and within 100?
9	Read your favourite book. Write a book review. Why is it your favourite book? Which is your favourite character and why? Where is it set? What is your favourite part of the story and why? Write why you would recommend it to a friend?
